



Fire Instructor I February 21-24th, 2008

What: 32-hour class based upon IFSTA “Fire and Emergency Services Instructor,” 7th edition, designed to prepare the student to meet the job performance requirements (JPR’s) contained in NFPA 1041, *Standard for Fire Service Instructor Professional Qualifications (2007)* for the position of Fire Instructor, level I. This class is equivalent to NWCG’s M-410, “Facilitative Instructor.” Includes pre-course reading and project assignments.



- Who:** The target audience includes fire department and wildfire agency personnel responsible for delivery of firefighter training sessions. Also helpful for individuals needing Fire Instructor I certification as a prerequisite for Fire Officer I.
- When:** February 21-24^h, 2008. Class will begin at 13:00, Thursday, February 21st and conclude at 17:00, Sunday, February 24th. Students can expect a rigorous schedule with morning, afternoon and evening sessions, in addition to nightly reading/project assignments.
- Where:** Colorado Firecamp at the Ponderosa Lodge, 12 miles west of Salida, ½ mile north of U.S. Highway 50 on County Road 240.
- Why:** This course is intended to fulfill the training requirement for state certification as Fire Instructor I, by preparing the student for later completion of NFPA 1041 JPR’s and Colorado Division of Fire Safety written test. Also meets NWCG instructor training requirements of the Field Manager’s Course Guide, PMS 901-1.
- Cost:** \$425 — includes tuition, IFSTA manual and study guide on cd-rom, 3 nights of lodging, and 10 meals (Thur. lunch thru Sun. lunch.) A reduced charge is offered to member agencies of the Upper Arkansas Valley Wildfire Council.
